### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► Colorado Springs dropped its first game of the 2017 season, snapping its three-game winning streak with an 8-3 loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers Sunday afternoon.  
 ► **Garrett Cooper** drove in a pair of runs on a two-run double as part of a three-run third inning to increase his RBI total to six through the first four games of 2017.

### INSIDE THE SERIES

► Despite the loss, the Sky Sox still managed to win three of the four games against Kansas City's top affiliate, winning in a multitude of ways.  
 ► Thursday's Opening Day victory came in the form of a 2-1 pitcher's duel, with **Ryan Cordell** providing all the offense on a RBI double in the 1st and a solo HR in the 4th.  
 ► Friday's 8-7 win in 10 innings provided the first walk-off win of 2017 after a 2016 season filled with Sky Sox comebacks. Down 5-2 heading to the 9th, **Nick Noonan** (RBI 1B) and **Eric Sogard** (2RBI 1B) sent the game to extras. Down 2 runs in the 10th, **Brett Phillips** re-tied the game with a two-run HR and **Kyle Wren** won it with a RBI 1B up the middle.  
 ► Saturday's 11-2 rout had plenty of offense, but not as much drama. The Sox scored three early runs in the first two innings and used a five-run 4th to put the game out of reach. **Brandon Woodruff** went 6.1 IP allowing an unearned run in his Triple-A debut, and **Yadiel Rivera** hit a solo HR and drove in 2 runs to give the shortstop a .500 average heading into Memphis.  
 ► The 3-0 start marked the 3rd time in team history that the Sox started a season with that record. The last two times were 2004 and 2009.

### TONIGHT'S STARTER

► LHP **Josh Hader** looks for his second start to open 2017 after earning the victory in Thursday's 2-1 win over Omaha at home.  
 ► Hader controlled the Storm Chasers during his five innings of work, allowing one hit and striking out six Omaha batters over 85 pitches.  
 ► Enters 2017 rated as the No. 2 Prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.  
 ► Hader became a Brewer after being acquired in a six-player trade which sent OF Carlos Gomez and RHP Mike Fiers to Houston on 7/30/2015.  
 ► Spent the rest of 2015 at Double-A Biloxi and was in Mississippi until his promotion to Colorado Springs on 6/11/2016.

### WALKING IN MEMPHIS

► The Sky Sox split the 2016 season series with an 8-8 record against the record, but the Sox look to improve on a 3-5 record in games played along the Mississippi River.  
 ► The last win at AutoZone Park came on June 10, 2016, when a solo shot by Will Middlebrooks gave Colorado Springs a 7-6 win in 10 innings.  
 ► The visitors hit three home runs on the evening, starting with Andy Wilkins' solo shot in the first inning and Middlebrooks' first of two long balls in the third inning.  
 ► The veteran third baseman led the way with three RBIs, while Wilkins drove in two. Rivera and Michael Reed each drove in one run in a two-run 8th inning which tied the game.  
 ► The Sox look to win their second straight road opener at Memphis, having defeated the Redbirds, 4-3, on 4/7/16. The visitors scored three in the final two innings to steal the win.

# 2017 SKY SOX COACHING STAFF



## RICK SWEET - MANAGER

**BORN:** SEPTEMBER 7, 1952, LONGVIEW, WA      **RESIDES:** BUCKEYE, AZ      **OPENING DAY AGE:** 64

Rick Sweet enters his fourth season in the Brewers organization and his third as manager of the Sky Sox. Prior to joining the organization in 2014 as manager of the Nashville Sounds, Sweet spent the previous nine seasons in the Reds organization as manager of the Louisville Bats (2005-11) and as the Reds' catching coordinator (2012-13).

The 2017 season marks his 27th year as a minor-league manager, a managerial career that dates back to 1987. As one of the most successful managers in Minor League Baseball, he owns a 1,794-1,739 (.508) career record and his 1,798 wins rank fourth-most among active minor league managers entering the 2017 season.

During Sweet's stint in Louisville from 2005-11, he became the franchise's all-time winningest manager with a 539-465 (.537) record. From 2008-10 his Bats won three straight International League West Division championships. He was named IL Manager of the Year in 2008 and 2009 and was *Baseball America's* 2010 Triple-A Manager of the Year. He was also recognized as Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 1994 while with Triple-A Tucson.



Sweet previously managed in the Seattle (1987-88), Houston (1989-95), New York - NL (1997), Montreal (1998, 2000), San Deigo (2001-03) and Detroit (2004) minor league systems. He served with the Astros as first base coach in 1996 and with the Expos as field coordinator from 1999-2000.

Sweet is a three-time Triple-A All-Star Game manager, having received the honor twice in the PCL with Tucson (1993) and Portland (2003), as well as with Louisville in the IL in 2009.

The former catcher had a nine-year playing career (1975-83) including three seasons in the majors with San Diego (1978), New York - NL (1982) and Seattle (1982-83). Following his playing days, Sweet became bullpen catcher for the Mariners (1984) and then spent the next two years as an advanced scout with Seattle (1985-86).

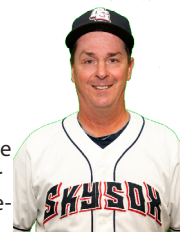
