#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- Colorado Springs dropped its first road game of the 2017 season, falling to the Memphis Redbirds Tuesday night by a 5-1 score.
- **Garrett Cooper** and **Eric Sogard** both singled to extend their hitting streaks to five and four games, respectively, and **Nick Noonan** hit a pinch-hit solo home run in the sixth inning to put the Sox on the scoreboard.

#### INSIDE THE GAME

- The Memphis Redbirds used four solo home runs and shut-down pitching to defeat the Sox, 5-1, in the series opener Tuesday night at AutoZone Park.
- Despite being held to five hits on the night, Noonan provided an offensive spark in the sixth inning, when he smacked his first home run of the season in a pinch-hit effort in the sixth innings.
- The home run marked the infielder's first long ball since August 27, 2016, when he hit a solo home run two batters into a matchup with the Albuquerque Isotopes. His El Paso Chihuahuas lost 5-4.
- In the team's first two pinch-hit at-bats of the 2017 season, the Sky Sox went 2-for-2, reaching safely in both attempts. Noonan led things off with the HR in the 6th and Ivan De Jesus recorded his first hit with the Sky Sox with a bloop single in the ninth inning.

#### EARLY PITCHING PROWESS

- **Tim Dillard** continued his early streak, throwing two scoreless innings in relief of starter Josh Hader.
- In 2017, the righty has thrown a total of three shutout frames, striking out three batters.
- This continues his 2016 trend from the pen, when he went 6-0 with a 2.78 ERA in 20 appearances as a reliever, earning one save on June 10 (the last win at Memphis)
- Looking to match Dillard's numbers as reliever is Sox newcomer **Tristan Archer**, who was promoted from Double-A Biloxi just before Tuesday's game. The RHP pitched a 1-2-3 8th inning, striking out two Redbirds in his Pacific Coast League debut.
- A graduate of Tennessee Tech University, Archer was drafted in the 21st round of the 2013 draft by Milwaukee.
- Archer pitched in two games for the Shuckers to start the 2017 season, and went 4-4 with a 3.42 ERA in 48 relief appearances and one start.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

- RHP **Matt Garza** takes the mound for his first rehab start as a member of the Colorado Springs Sky Sox.
- The Californian makes his first 2017 regular season appearance after landing on the disabled list after a groin strain on March 31.
- Made three appearances for the Class-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in 2016 after going on the DL with a right lat strain.
- Tonight marks his second stint with a Pacific Coast League squad, having made a pair of rehab starts for the Iowa Cubs in May of 2013.
- Went 6-8 in 2016 with a 4.51 ERA, allowing 51 ER and striking out 70 in 101.2 IP with Milwaukee.

#### WALKING IN MEMPHIS

- The Sky Sox split the 2016 season series with an 8-8 record against the record, but the Sox look to improve on a 3-5 record in games played along the Mississippi River.
- The last win at AutoZone Park came on June 10, 2016, when a solo shot by Will Middlebrooks gave Colorado Springs a 7-6 win in 10 innings.
- The visitors hit three home runs on the evening, starting with Andy Wilkins' solo shot in the first inning and Middlebrooks' first of two long balls in the third inning.
- The veteran third baseman led the way with three RBIs, while Wilkins drove in two. Rivera and Michael Reed each drove in one run in a two-run 8th inning which tied the game.

#### MAINTAINING THE STREAKS

- With two of the five hits in Tuesday night's loss, the right side of the infield continued their early-season hitting streaks.
- Starting every game at first base five games into the year, Cooper has also recorded a hit in every 2017 game, including a pair of two-hit games against Omaha. The 6'6" righty also leads the team with six RBIs, including four on April 8 v. Omaha.
- Cooper owned a 12-game hitting streak from June 19 to July 4, 2016 with the Sox, where he hit .383 (18-for-47) with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a .453 on-base percentage.
- Meanwhile, one infield position over, Sogard has played in four of the five games this season, recording at least one hit in each game he's appeared in. The MLB veteran is tied for the team lead with four runs scored (**Kyle Wren**).

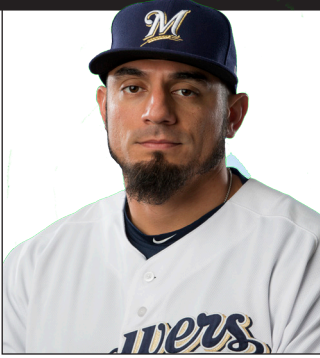

**THE GARZA FILE: 2016:** Went 6-8 with a 4/51 ERA in 19 starts for Milwaukee...Produced seven quality starts, going 4-0 with a 2.49 ERA in those starts (43.1 IP, 12 ER)...Began the season on the 15-day Disabled List with a right lat strain after he was injured during his final Spring Training start 4/1 at Houston....Transferred to the 60-day DL on April 28...Was reinstated from the disabled list on 6/14 after making three rehab starts at Class -A Wisconsin. **2015:** Went 6-14 with a 5.63 ERA in 26 games (25 starts)...Made his only relief appearance of the season (4th of his career) on 5/31 vs. Arizona and earned the win in a 7-6, 17 inning victory...Was placed on the DL from 7/6-7/20 (retroactive to 7/3), with right shoulder tendinitis...**2014:** Signed as a free agent with Milwaukee on 1/26...Went 8-8 with a 3.64 ERA in 27 starts in his first season with the Brewers...Opponents batted just .233 (7th in NL and the 6th-lowest in franchise history)...Made his MIL debut on 4/2 vs. Atlanta and took a no-hitter into the seventh inning before allowing a solo HR to Chris Johnson (L, 1-0)...Named Brewers Pitcher of the Month after going 3-1 with a 2.88 ERA.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Strained his right groin before the start of the 2017 season, making 4/12 his first regular-season appearance.

### AGAINST THE REDBIRDS

- This will be Garza's second appearance in the Pacific Coast League, having made two rehab appearances with the Iowa Cubs in 2013.
- Earned a no-decision on May 6 in a Cubs' 6-1 win over Oklahoma City and earned the win May 16 against the Tucson Padres.
