IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- ▶ Colorado Springs won its first game away from Security Service Field Wednesday, scoring in four different innings to defeat the Redbirds, 8-2.
- ▶ **Paolo Espino** earned his first Pacific Coast League win, throwing six innings of five-hit, six strikeout ball. Carson Kelly's two-run home run in the fifth inning was the only offense Memphis mustered against the right-hander.

INSIDE THE GAME

- ▶ Taking a page out of Memphis' book from the first two games, it was the Sky Sox who utilized a leadoff home run to open the scoring. **Lewis Brinson**, playing in his first action since Opening Day, launched a shoulder-high pitch deep over the left field wall in the first at-bat of the game to put Colorado Springs up 1-0.
- ▶ Offensively, the Sox were led by **Garrett Cooper**, who went 4-for-5 to extend his season-opening hitting streak to seven games.
- ▶ The first baseman recorded two singles, a two-run double (7th inning) and a solo home run (4th inning), falling a triple shy of the cycle.
- ▶ Like Brinson, another Sox hitter making his first appearance after extended time recovering from injury was **Andrew Susac**. The rehabbing catcher went 1-for-4, driving in a run in the fourth inning on a Baltimore chop over the head of Patrick Wisdom to score Eric Sogard.

BULLPEN STEPPING UP

- ▶ Despite the slow start to the road schedule, the Sky Sox bullpen has risen to the occasion, throwing a combined 8 innings while allowing three earned runs and striking out nine Redbirds.
- ▶ **Tim Dillard**, **Tyler Cravy**, **Tristan Archer** and **Stephen Kohlscheen** and **Wei-Chung Wang** all have thrown scoreless outings while in West Tennessee.
- ▶ Thanks in part to the bullpen, Colorado Springs owns a 3.48 team earned run average, which places them fourth in the Pacific Coast League.
- ▶ As a whole, the Sky Sox pitching staff is also in the PCL top-5 in both runs allowed (5th, 27) and earned runs allowed (T-3rd, 24).

TONIGHT'S STARTER

- ▶ **RHP Brandon Woodruff** makes his second start of the season, looking for his first win in the Pacific Coast League.
- ▶ The native of Booneville, Miss., and Mississippi State alum returns to the Deep South after earning a victory April 8 against Omaha (6.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 4 K.)
- ▶ 2017 marks his 4th professional season, having been drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 11th round of the 2014 Draft.
- ▶ Spent 2016 between the Class-A Advanced Brevard County Manatees and the Double-A Biloxi Shuckers, going a combined 14-9 with a 2.68 ERA and 173 strikeouts
- ▶ Those 173 punchouts led all of Minor League Baseball, as well as the honor of Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

WALKING IN MEMPHIS

- ▶ The Sky Sox split the 2016 season series with an 8-8 record against the record, but the Sox look to improve on a 3-5 record in games played along the Mississippi River.
- ▶ The last win before Thursday night at AutoZone Park came on June 10, 2016, when a solo shot by Will Middlebrooks gave Colorado Springs a 7-6 win in 10 innings.
- ▶ The visitors hit three home runs on the evening, starting with Andy Wilkins' solo shot in the first inning and Middlebrooks' first of two long balls in the third inning.
- ▶ The veteran third baseman led the way with three RBIs, while Wilkins drove in two. Rivera and Michael Reed each drove in one run in a two-run 8th inning which tied the game.

COOPER WATCH

- ▶ After hitting a single in the first inning, Cooper now owns a seven-game hitting streak, recording at least one hit in each 2017 game for the Sox.
- ▶ The 6'6" first baseman out of Auburn University recorded a 12-game hitting streak from June 19 to July 4 as a member of the Sox in 2016, when he went 18-for-47 with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a .453 on-base percentage.
- ▶ Out of the Sox players that have played in more than one game, Cooper leads the team with a .484 OBP and a .714 Slugging Percentage (Tied in SLG with Brinson).
- ▶ The Southern California native also is the team leader in doubles (5), RBI (10), hits (12), and total bases (20).
