IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► Colorado Springs earned a series split to cap off its four-game series at Memphis Friday night, tossing a combined one-hitter to defeat the Redbirds, 3-1 at AutoZone Park.

► **Brandon Woodruff** earned his second win of his Triple-A career, tossing five innings while striking out five Memphis batters and allowing a single hit to shortstop Paul DeJong in the fourth inning.

INSIDE THE GAME

► **Tristan Archer, Michael Blazek and Rob Scahill** each threw scoreless outings in relief of Woodruff, helping combine for the fourth nine-inning one-hitter in Sky Sox history and the first since May 13, 2006, when the Sox pulled off the feat at Johnny Rosenblatt Stadium in Omaha, Neb.

► Offensively, the Sox were led by **Ryan Cordell**, who recorded all the RBIs for the second time this season (Last time: 4/7 v. Omaha).

► After Memphis took a 1-0 lead on a dropped double play ball, Cordell gave the visitors the lead with a two-run home run in the third inning. His second long ball of 2017 landed halfway up the hill in left field at AutoZone Park, scoring **Eric Sogard** in the process.

► Entering the game in a 1-for-17 slump, **Ivan De Jesus** broke out with a 4-for-4 outing--the second straight night that a Sky Sox hitter recorded a quartet of hits (Cooper, 4/13).

► After tripling to lead off the fourth inning, De Jesus came in to score the key insurance run on an 0-2 wild pitch from Memphis starter Mike Mayers.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

► **LHP Brent Suter** makes his first start of 2017 after joining the club at the beginning of the road trip.

► The native of Chicago went 6-6 with a 3.50 ERA and two saves in 26 appearances (15 starts) with the Sky Sox in 2016.

► Made his MLB debut on August 29, 2016, going 2-2 with a 3.32 ERA in 14 games (2 starts) for the Milwaukee Brewers.

► Appeared in three games for Milwaukee to start the 2017 season before being optioned to Colorado Springs on April 9.

► Selected by the Brewers in the 31st round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft

► Suter was named the Sky Sox Pitcher of the Month during the months of June and July.

► Recorded the club's 8th four-inning save in team history on May 27 at Fresno.

COOPER WATCH

► After hitting a single in the fifth inning, Cooper now owns an eight-game hitting streak, recording at least one hit in each 2017 game for the Sox.

► The 6'6" first baseman out of Auburn University recorded a 12-game hitting streak from June 19 to July 4 as a member of the Sox in 2016, when he went 18-for-47 with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a .453 on-base percentage.

► Out of the Sox players that have started more than one game, Cooper leads the team with a .394 batting average, 444 OBP and a .636 Slugging Percentage.

► The Southern California native also is the team leader in doubles (5), RBI (10), hits (12), and total bases (21).
