IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- ▶ Colorado Springs had the series finale with the Nashville Sounds postponed due to rain in Middle Tennessee. The game will be made up as part of a doubleheader in Music City on May 28, starting at 3:05 p.m. MT.
- ▶ Monday night marked the first game of 2017 postponed due to inclement weather conditions. The Sky Sox had 13 games scrapped or rescheduled due to bad weather during the 2016 season.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- ▶ The Sky Sox earned their first series sweep of the 2017 season, defeating the Nashville Sounds Saturday night and Sunday afternoon before being rained out Monday night in the Tennessee capital.
- ▶ The Sox outscored the Sounds, 11-2, over the two games, holding Nashville to a single run in each game.
- ▶ Colorado Springs received standout pitching from LHP **Brent Suter** and **Josh Hader**, who went 5 IP and 6 IP, respectively. Suter threw five scoreless frame, while Hader allowed 1 ER and threw his second one-hit outing of the young season.
- ▶ **Garrett Cooper** extended his season-opening hitting streak to 10 games with a pair of singles in each of the two games. On Saturday, Cooper led off the eighth inning with a single and eventually scored the first of two insurance runs. On Sunday, the first baseman grounded a RBI single up the middle to plate the first Sox run of the game, which was subsequently followed by a **Brett Phillips** RBI single to give the visitors a 2-0 lead.
- ▶ Speaking of the outfielder, Phillips finished with a 3-for-5 day from the plate Sunday with three singles and a run scored during the middle three at-bats. The three hits are a new season-high for the outfielder, who has five hits in his last two games in Nashville.

OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS!

- ▶ Entering its 11th game of the season, the Sky Sox are 2nd in the Pacific Coast League in ERA (2.63), Runs/ER allowed (30/26) and 1st in the league in hits allowed (68).
- ▶ Through five road games, the Sox bullpen has allowed just four runs through 22 innings of work (that's a 1.64 ERA).

TONIGHT'S STARTER

- ▶ RHP **Paolo Espino** makes his third start of the season, coming off his first win in the Pacific Coast League on April 13.
- ▶ The native of Panama and graduate of The Pendleton School in Bradenton, Fla., defeated Memphis by allowing two runs and striking out six Redbirds over six innings.
- ▶ 2017 marks his 11th professional season, having been drafted by the Cleveland Indians in 10th round of the 2006 Draft.
- ▶ Spent 2016 with the Triple-A Syracuse Chiefs (Washington), where he went 8-11 with a 3.30 ERA in 26 appearances (24 starts).
- ▶ Signed as a minor league free agent with the Brewers on November 10, 2016, with an invitation to Spring Training.
- ▶ Represented his home country of Panama in the 2006 and 2009 World Baseball Classic, as well as in the 2013 and 2017 WBC qualifiers.

COOPER WATCH

- ▶ After hitting a single in the fifth inning Sunday, Cooper now owns a 10-game hitting streak, recording at least one hit in each 2017 game for the Sox.
- ▶ The 6'6" first baseman out of Auburn University recorded a 12-game hitting streak from June 19 to July 4 as a member of the Sox in 2016, when he went 18-for-47 with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a .453 on-base percentage.
- ▶ Out of the Sox players that have started more than one game, Cooper leads the team with a .349 batting average, .391 OBP and a .535 Slugging Percentage.
- ▶ The Southern California native also is the team leader in doubles (5), RBI (11), hits (15), and total bases (23).
- ▶ In 2015, Cooper led all Brewers minor leaguers in batting average (.310) in 128 games being Class-A Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Biloxi.

LONG TIME, NO SEE

- ▶ A week before starting the first home series with Memphis, the two teams split a four-game set in West Tennessee, with the Sox winning the final two games.
- ▶ After being held to two runs in the first two losses, the Sox exploded for eight runs in an 8-2 game three win Thursday, and then turned the tables with a combined one-hitter (3-1 W) Friday.
