IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► Colorado Springs turned on the offense once again Wednesday, scoring four runs in the third and seven runs in the seventh to blow open a close game and defeat the Memphis Redbirds, 13-4, at Security Service Field.

► With the win, the Sky Sox set a franchise record for the best start to a season through 12 games at 9-3. The win also marked six consecutive wins for the first time since July 2012.

INSIDE THE GAME

► Once again, the Memphis Redbirds jumped out to an early lead. After a bases-loaded walk in the second inning, the Birds led 3-1. From there, the Sox went on a 13-1 scoring run to close out the game.

► Outfielder **Brett Phillips** led the offensive attack in his first game in the cleanup spot. The lefty went 2-for-3 with a pair of home runs and six RBIs, accounting for almost half of the Sox offense.

► Phillips helped the Sox take the lead with a grand slam in the third inning. The grand slam was the ninth grand slam hit by a Sky Sox player against Memphis pitching (and fourth in last three seasons as a Milwaukee affiliate).

► **Eric Sogard** started the offense for the Sox, cranking his second home runs of the season down the left field line. The second baseman went 3-for-4 from the plate with three runs scored and three more runs driven in.

► **Kyle Wren** (2 RBI), **Ivan De Jesus** (1 RBI) and **Yadiel Rivera** (1 RBI) also contributed to the box score with at least one run driven in each.

► On the mound, RHP **Brandon Woodruff** remained undefeated after going 5 innings, scattering seven hits and allowing four earned runs.

OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS!

► Entering its 13th game of the season, the Sky Sox are 1st in the Pacific Coast League in ERA (2.86), Earned Runs allowed (34) and hits allowed (87) and 2nd in the PCL in Runs allowed (38).

► Since 4/11, the Sox bullpen has allowed just four runs through 29.2 innings of work (that's a 1.21 ERA).

TONIGHT'S STARTER

► LHP **Brent Suter** makes his first home start of 2017 after joining the club at the beginning of the road trip in Memphis.

► In his first outing at Nashville, Suter earned the win by tossing five shutout innings and scattering four hits, helping the Sox defeat the Sounds, 6-1.

► The native of Chicago went 6-6 with a 3.50 ERA and two saves in 26 appearances (15 starts) with the Sky Sox in 2016.

► Made his MLB debut on August 29, 2016, going 2-2 with a 3.32 ERA in 14 games (2 starts) for the Milwaukee Brewers.

► Appeared in three games for Milwaukee to start the 2017 season before being optioned to Colorado Springs on April 9.

► Selected by the Brewers in the 31st round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft

► Suter was named the Sky Sox Pitcher of the Month during the months of June and July

COOPER WATCH

► After hitting a single in the eighth inning Tuesday, **Garrett Cooper** now owns a 11-game hitting streak, recording at least one hit in each 2017 start for the Sox.

► Due to a note in the MLB rulebook, Cooper's hitting streak is intact, even though he recorded a walk in his only plate appearance Wednesday.

► The 6'6" first baseman out of Auburn University recorded a 12-game hitting streak from 6/19 to 7/4 with the Sox in 2016, when he went 18-for-47 with 8 runs, 5 doubles, 2 HR, 10 RBI and a .453 on-base percentage.

► The Southern California native is the team leader in doubles (5), RBI (12) and hits (16).

► In 2015, Cooper led all Brewers minor leaguers in batting average (.310) in 128 games being Class-A Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Biloxi.

ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox lead all of Triple-A baseball with the 9-3 record...they also have a +37 run differential, which happens to lead all of domestic minor league baseball.
