IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► Colorado Springs continued their season-opening winning streak, battling around in the fourth inning en route to an 11-2 rout.
► **Brandon Woodruff** threw 6.1 innings in his first Triple-A start and **Garrett Cooper** drove in four runs, three of which coming on a bases-clearing double.

INSIDE THE VICTORY

► Coming off a wild extra-inning thriller Friday night, the Sky Sox jumped out to a quick lead in the first couple innings. Two batters in, **Eric Sogard** crushed his first home run of the 2017 campaign to right field to put the hosts up 1-0. Colorado Springs added two more runs in the second inning for a quick 3-0 lead.
► The offensive flood gates opened in the fourth inning, as the Sox sent all nine batters to the plate in an inning which knocked out Royals' No. 1 prospect Josh Staumont from the game. **Yadiel Rivera** smacked a solo shot to the scoreboard in left-centerfield for his second RBI of the day and Cooper cleared the bases five batters later to break the game open in support of Woodruff on the mound.

TODAY'S STARTER

► RHP **Hiram Burgos** takes the mound for the first time this season against Omaha EHP Luke Farrell.
► The 2016 Sky Sox Pitcher of the Year finished the season with a 10-1 record and a 4.40 ERA, winning five of his last six decisions to earn the honor.
► The righty was drafted in the 6th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Fla.
► Along with winning Pitcher of the Year, Burgos also was named the Sox Pitcher of the Month for August and September
► Helped lead Team Puerto Rico to the World Baseball Classic championship in 2017...also pitched for PR in 2013.

EARLY SEASON STREAKING

► Three games into the 2017, a group of Sky Sox hitters have started the season on a hot streak.
► Cooper, Ryan Cordell, Brett Phillips, Rivera and Sogard all look to extend their three-game hitting streaks Sunday, while Kyle Wren has a two-game streak in his first two starts.

BRINSON ENTERS SEASON AS TOP PROSPECT

► For the second straight season, the Sky Sox roster features the Brewers' No. 1 prospect, according to MLB Pipeline and *Baseball America*. Outfielder **Lewis Brinson** also enters the 2017 season as the No. 18 overall minor league prospect on MLB.com.
► Brinson was sent to Colorado Springs after a 8/1 trade with Texas and batted .382 with four home runs, 20 RBI and four stolen bases in 23 games.
► Before being traded, Brinson hit .237 with 14 doubles, six triples (2nd in Texas League), 11 home runs and 40 RBIs in 77 games.
► Produced the first 20 HR/20 SB season in Hickory Crawdads history in 2013
► Was named to Milwaukee's 40-man roster on 11/18.

MEET THE SKY SOX

► The Sky Sox roster features five of Milwaukee's top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, including the two of the top three overall prospects in outfielder Lewis Brinson (1) and pitcher Josh Hader (3). Pitcher Brandon Woodruff (8) along with outfielders Brett Phillips (10) and Ryan Cordell (16) join Brinson and Hader as Milwaukee's top-prospects on the Sky Sox roster.
► The roster includes nine members of Milwaukee's current 40-man roster. That list includes Brinson, Cordell, Hader, Phillips, as well as pitchers Michael Blazek, Taylor Jungmann, Damien Magnifico, Brett Suter and infielder Yadiel Rivera.

UNCHARTERED TERRITORY

► The 3-0 start to 2017 marks the third time in Sky Sox history where the teams starts the season with a 3-0 record (last two times were 2004 and 2009).
► The Sox are looking to start 4-0 for the first time in club history.

YADI EN FUEGO!

► Through the early part of April, Rivera has gotten off to the hottest start among the high-octane Sox offense.
► In his first three games in 2017, the shortstop is hitting .500 to lead the Sox, going 6-for-12 with a home run, two runs scored and two RBIs. Rivera went 2-for-4 with the HR and both RBIs Saturday to add to his three-hit game Friday night.

RICK SWEET - MANAGER

BORN: SEPTEMBER 7, 1952, LONGVIEW, WA **RESIDES:** BUCKEYE, AZ **OPENING DAY AGE:** 64

Rick Sweet enters his fourth season in the Brewers organization and his third as manager of the Sky Sox. Prior to joining the organization in 2014 as manager of the Nashville Sounds, Sweet spent the previous nine seasons in the Reds organization as manager of the Louisville Bats (2005-11) and as the Reds' catching coordinator (2012-13).

The 2017 season marks his 27th year as a minor-league manager, a managerial career that dates back to 1987. As one of the most successful managers in Minor League Baseball, he owns a 1,794-1,739 (.508) career record and his 1,798 wins rank fourth-most among active minor league managers entering the 2017 season.

During Sweet's stint in Louisville from 2005-11, he became the franchise's all-time winningest manager with a 539-465 (.537) record. From 2008-10 his Bats won three straight International League West Division championships. He was named IL Manager of the Year in 2008 and 2009 and was *Baseball America's* 2010 Triple-A Manager of the Year. He was also recognized as Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 1994 while with Triple-A Tucson.



Sweet previously managed in the Seattle (1987-88), Houston (1989-95), New York - NL (1997), Montreal (1998, 2000), San Deigo (2001-03) and Detroit (2004) minor league systems. He served with the Astros as first base coach in 1996 and with the Expos as field coordinator from 1999-2000.

Sweet is a three-time Triple-A All-Star Game manager, having received the honor twice in the PCL with Tucson (1993) and Portland (2003), as well as with Louisville in the IL in 2009.

The former catcher had a nine-year playing career (1975-83) including three seasons in the majors with San Diego (1978), New York - NL (1982) and Seattle (1982-83). Following his playing days, Sweet became bullpen catcher for the Mariners (1984) and then spent the next two years as an advanced scout with Seattle (1985-86).

Coaching Highlights: Begins his third season as pitching coach for the Sky Sox and 14th overall season with the Brewers. He joined the organization as pitching coach at Class-AA Huntsville in 2004, spent seven seasons in the same capacity at Brevard County from 2005-11 and spent the last three seasons with Triple-A Nashville as their pitching coach. During the 2010 season, Dabney served as interim bullpen coach for the Brewers from April 23 to May 23. He took the place of Stan Kyles, who underwent surgery in April. Prior to joining the Brewers, Dabney spent five seasons as a pitching coach in the Texas Rangers organization with the Rookie GCL Rangers (1999), Class-A Savannah (2000), Class-A Charlotte (2001-02) and Class-A Stockton (2003). While with Charlotte, he coached in the Florida State League All-Star Game both seasons. His staff posted a league-best 3.40 ERA in 2002 and ranked third with a 3.37 ERA in 2001.



Playing Career: Dabney played nine minor league seasons as a pitcher with Chicago-AL (1988-93), Cleveland (1994) and Chicago-NL (1995-96) and finished his career in Taiwan (1997). He was originally chosen by the White Sox in the 15th round of the 1988 draft after attending Seminole (OK) Junior College.

AL LEBOEUF - COACH

BORN: February 4, 1960, Putnam, CT **RESIDES:** Palm Harbor, FL **OPENING DAY AGE:** 56

Coaching Highlights: Al LeBoeuf, 56, enters his first season with the Sky Sox and eighth with the Brewers organization. Previously he served as a coach with the Class-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers during the 2016 season. He spent 2014 and 2015 as a hitting advisor for the Brewers at the team's Maryvale complex and spent the 2013 season as a player development scout. He served as a coach for Triple-A Nashville in 2012 and for Double-A Huntsville during the 2010 and 2011 seasons.



NED YOST IV - COACH

BORN: July 8, 1982, Jackson, MS **RESIDES:** LaGrange, GA **OPENING DAY AGE:** 34

Coaching Highlights: Ned Yost IV, 34, begins his 10th season as a coach with the Brewers and his first with the Sky Sox. He previously spent five seasons as a coach with the Class-A Advanced Brevard County Manatees from 2012-2016. He also spent three seasons with Rookie-level Helena from 2009-11 and was an assistant coach with Helena in 2008.
