IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- ▶ The Colorado Springs Sky Sox extended their winning streak to five games Tuesday afternoon, with an 8-5 win over the Fresno Grizzlies.
- ▶ The victory marked a four-game sweep of the Grizzlies--the first time against Fresno since 2011 and the first sweep against any Pacific Coast League opponent since July 22-25, 2016.

ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

- ▶ Despite playing at the highest altitude in all of Minor League Baseball, the Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major categories.
- ▶ Colorado Springs is currently tops in the PCL in slugging percentage and 2nd in team batting average behind Reno.
- ▶ The Sox also sit near the top of the hitter-friendly PCL in pitching statistics, placing second in the league in Earned Run Average behind Oklahoma City and first in Runs Allowed, Hits Allowed and Earned Runs Allowed.
- ▶ This potent combination has given the Sox the best record in the Pacific Coast league and the best winning percentage out of all American professional baseball teams.

GUARDIANS OF THE STOLEN BASE

- ▶ The catching duo of **Andrew Susac** and **Tyler Heineman** currently leads the PCL in caught stealing percentage. Opposing runners are 7-for-19 (.632) against the pair (lone duo > .500)
- ▶ Heineman leads all PCL catchers, throwing out seven runners in 12 attempts, good for a .583 mark.

PRODUCING IN BUNCHES

- ▶ After Tuesday's home game, the Sky Sox boast eight players with 74+ at-bats and at least a .300 batting average (**Eric Sogard**, **Kyle Wren**, **Garrett Cooper**, **Ivan De Jesus**, **Lewis Brinson**, **Yadiel Rivera**, **Ryan Cordell**, **Brett Phillips**).
- ▶ The same eight guys also have at least 25 hits each this season, with the team combining for 78 multi-hit games in 2017.
- ▶ The Sox also have eight guys who have driven in at least 10 RBIs through the first 28 games of the season (Cooper - 31, Phillips - 26, Cordell - 20, Sogard - 17, Brinson/De Jesus - 13, Susac - 12, Wren - 10). The Sky Sox have combined for 43 multi-RBI games in 2017.

TODAY'S STARTER

- ▶ LHP **Brent Suter** makes his second start and third appearance of 2017 after re-joining the club on April 24.
- ▶ The lefty won his second 2017 start, allowing two earned runs in five innings, while receiving a lot of run support in a 15-3 romp at Oklahoma City May 5.
- ▶ Suter took the loss in his lone relief appearance May 1 at Iowa, allowing two earned runs in Iowa's 3-2 matinee win in Des Moines.
- ▶ The native of Chicago went 6-6 with a 3.50 ERA and two saves in 26 appearances (15 starts) with the Sky Sox in 2016.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on August 29, 2016, going 2-2 with a 3.32 ERA in 14 games (2 starts) for the Milwaukee Brewers.
- ▶ Appeared in three games for Milwaukee to start the 2017 season before being optioned to Colorado Springs on April 9.
- ▶ Selected by the Brewers in the 31st round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft
- ▶ Suter was named the Sky Sox Pitcher of the Month during the months of June and July.
- ▶ Recorded the club's 8th four-inning save in team history on May 27 at Fresno.

CONSISTENT COOPER

- ▶ First baseman **Garrett Cooper** was named the Sky Sox Player of the Month for the month of April, finishing the month with a .320 batting average in 19 games during the season's first month.
- ▶ A model of consistency in the middle of the potent Sox lineup, Cooper leads the team with 31 RBIs through 28 games, which places him alone in third place in the PCL.
- ▶ Cooper also leads Colorado Springs in total hits (38), doubles (11), slugging percentage (.588), and is tied for the team lead in home runs with **Brett Phillips** (6).
- ▶ The first baseman has recorded a pair of lengthy hitting streaks...He started the season on 12-game season-opening streak and had a 10-game tear which ended Tuesday.
- ▶ Cooper's season-high in production came April 13 at AutoZone Park, when he torched Memphis pitching, going 4-for-5 with 2 runs and 4 RBIs (tied the RBI mark 5/5 in OK City).
