#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► The Colorado Springs Sky Sox enter Thursday with a chance to clinch another road series after defeating the El Paso Chihuahuas, 4-2, Wednesday afternoon

► **Angel Ventura** won his Triple-A debut by throwing six innings, allowing two runs in the second inning. The Sox offense benefited from a collective effort, led by Nate Orf, who drove in a run in the two-run first inning and scored the go-ahead run in the two-run seventh inning.

#### REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major categories.

► Colorado Springs is currently second in the PCL in both slugging percentage and in team batting average (tied with Salt Lake) behind the Reno Aces.

► The Sox also sit in the top half of the hitter-friendly PCL in pitching statistics, placing third in the league in hits allowed behind Tacoma and Omaha, and fifth in earned runs allowed, total runs allowed and earned run average.

► This combination has given the Sox the best record in the PCL in terms of winning percentage, .08 ahead of Tacoma.

#### GUARDIANS OF THE STOLEN BASE

► The catching trio of **Andrew Susac**, **Tyler Heineman** and **Rene Garcia** currently leads the PCL in caught stealing percentage, throwing out 16 of 27 runners (.593)

► Heineman sits atop the PCL leaderboard, throwing out 10 of 18 runners (.556).

#### PRODUCING IN BUNCHES

► After Wednesday's game, the Sky Sox boast six players with 74+ at-bats and at least a .300 batting average (**Ivan De Jesus**, **Garrett Cooper**, **Lewis Brinson**, **Kyle Wren**, **Ryan Cordell**, **Brett Phillips**).

► The same six guys (plus **Yadiel Rivera**) have at least 25 hits each this season, with the team combining for 94 multi-hit games in 2017.

► The Sox also have nine guys who have driven in at least 10 RBIs through the first 32 games of the season (Cooper - 38, Phillips - 31, Cordell - 25, Brinson/De Jesus - 15, Wren - 14, Rivera/Susac - 12, Orf - 10). The team has combined for 52 multi-RBI games in 2017.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

► RHP **Brandon Woodruff** makes his sixth start of the season, looking for his sixth win in seven outings in his first season in the Pacific Coast League.

► The native of Booneville, Miss., and Mississippi State alum dropped his first game of the 2017 season on May 13, allowing five earned runs in 4.2 innings in an 11-2 loss to the Sacramento River Cats.

► Woodruff still ranks among the PCL's top pitchers, sitting in a tie for eighth in WHIP (1.05) with Oklahoma City's Wilmer Font and alone in eighth in earned run average (2.77)

► 2017 marks his 4th professional season, having been drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 11th round of the 2014 Draft.

► Spent 2016 between the Class-A Advanced Brevard County Manatees and the Double-A Biloxi Shuckers, going a combined 14-9 with a 2.68 ERA and 173 strikeouts

► Those 173 punchouts led all of Minor League Baseball, as well as the honor of Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

#### RYAN CONTINUES TO RAKE

► The No. 18 prospect in Milwaukee's system has batted in the No. 3 slot in all but seven of the Sky Sox games in 2017, posting a .317 average to start his first year in Triple-A.

► Cordell has heated up in his last ten games, leading the team with a .344 average with 11 hits, one home run, seven runs scored and five RBIs.

► The Liberty University product leads the Sky Sox in Total Runs Scored (29), while sitting second in Hits (40) and On-Base Percentage (.389), and third in Slugging Percentage (.563), OPS (.952), Home Runs (6) and RBIs (25).

► With this hot streak, Cordell sits in a tie for sixth in the Pacific Coast League in runs scored, a tie for ninth place in slugging percentage and tenth in OPS.

#### DON'T FORGET MAV

► So far, Brett Phillips has enjoyed his first Triple-A trip to the Southwest, going 5-for-14 with five extra base hits, two home runs, five RBIs and five runs scored.

► The third Sox outfielder within the top-20 prospects in the Milwaukee system leads the team in long balls (8) Slugging Percentage (.609) and OPS (.993), is second in RBIs (32), and is third in On-Base Percentage (.385).
