IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► Colorado Springs and Oklahoma City played a 14-inning, 4:34 contest at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark, with the Sky Sox pulling out an 8-6 victory over the Dodgers.

► **Ivan De Jesus** and **Stephen Kohlscheen** provided the late-inning heroics, driving in two-out runs on a triple and a single, respectively. Kohlscheen ended up as the victor on the mound as well, with **Michael Blazek** retiring the final batter to record his first save.

ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► Despite playing at the highest altitude in all of Minor League Baseball, the Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major categories.

► Colorado Springs is currently 4th in the PCL in both team slugging percentage and batting average behind Salt Lake, Reno and Fresno.

► The Sox also sit near the top of the hitter-friendly PCL in pitching statistics as well, placing 3rd in the league in ERA behind Oklahoma City and Omaha, and first in Hits Allowed, Runs Allowed and Earned Runs Allowed.

► This potent combination has given the Sox the second-best record in Triple-A baseball, based on winning percentage (tops in the PCL...Durham [International League] has a .708 winning percentage).

A MARATHON, NOT A SPRINT

► For as many times as Colorado Springs and Oklahoma City have played each other, Tuesday marked the longest game in the history of the matchup, both in innings and in time.

► Previously, the longest game in terms of innings was 13 on May 9, 1999, when the Sky Sox defeated the Oklahoma Redhaws, 8-7. Both pitching staffs struck out 16 batters in the contest.

► The previous long in terms of time was 4 hours and 10 minutes, which happened on June 4, 2007 in the Oklahoma capital city. The hosts won that matchup, 5-4, in 11 innings.

IVAN HEATING UP

► After starting the season 1-for-17, Ivan De Jesus has strung together a four-game hitting streak and is now batting .309 through his 17 appearances.

► Since his four-hit outing April 14 at Memphis, De Jesus has gone 16-for-36 with seven runs scored, three doubles, a triple and five RBIs to add another offensive threat to the already potent Sky Sox lineup.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

► LHP **Josh Hader** makes his sixth start of 2017 and second of this American North road trip to Iowa and Oklahoma City.

► The native of Millersville, MD, went 3-8 with a 3.29 ERA in 25 starts between Double-A Biloxi and Triple-A Colorado Springs in 2016.

► Named the 2017 Opening Day starter and shut down the Omaha Storm Chasers on April 7, scattering five hits and striking out five Storm Chasers while allowing a single hit in the 2-1 Sox victory.

► Took a no-decision April 27 in Des Moines after allowing five earned runs and striking out five Cubs in 4 2/3 innings at Principal Park.

► Enters 2017 as the No. 2 prospect in the Milwaukee system, according to Baseball America

► Acquired by the Brewers as part of a six-player trade on July 30, 2015 that sent Carlos Gomez and Mike Fiers to Houston in exchange for Adrian Houser, Phillips, Domingo Santana and Hader.

PRODUCING IN BUNCHES

► Outfielder **Brett Phillips** currently leads the Sky Sox in slugging percentage (.600) and home runs (5), which also places Phillips in the top-10 in the Pacific Coast League (8th in Slugging, T-9th in Home Runs).

► Phillips is second on the team with 18 RBIs (four behind **Garrett Cooper's** 22) and has four multi-RBI games through the first 21 games of 2017.

► Tuesday night marked his first three-RBI game of the season, and he recorded consecutive two-RBI outings April 7 and 8 at home against Omaha, the first of which came in the form of a game-tying two-run home run in the 10th inning.

► The other multi-RBI outing was the first morning start of the season against Memphis on April 19, when Phillips went 2-for-3 with two home runs (including a grand slam) and drove in a season-high six RBIs, the most for any Sox player through the first month of 2017.

SOME GOOD, OLD-FASHIONED HOME COOKING

► A native of nearby Norman, Oklahoma, Kohlscheen made his mark pitching in front of the "home crowd", earning the win in relief and driving in a key insurance run on a RBI single.

► That hit had a bit of sentimental importance as well, as the single was Kohlscheen's first career hit, having struck out in his previous two plate appearances.
