#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

- ▶ Colorado Springs bounced back from Thursday afternoon's loss in a massive way, belting a season-high 21 hits en route to a 15-3 romp to take three of four games in Oklahoma City.
- ▶ **Garrett Cooper** belted his fifth home run of the season and drove 4 RBI. **Eric Sogard** drove in three runs, while **Kirk Nieuwenhuis** broke out of his early slump with a 3-hit, 2-RBI night.

#### ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

- ▶ Despite playing at the highest altitude in all of Minor League Baseball, the Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major categories.
- ▶ Colorado Springs is currently 2nd in the PCL in slugging percentage and 4th in team batting percentage.
- ▶ The Sox also sit at the top of the hitter-friendly PCL in pitching statistics, placing first in the league in Earned Run Average, Hits Allowed, Runs Allowed and Earned Runs Allowed.
- ▶ This potent combination has given the Sox the best record in the Pacific Coast league and second in Triple-A baseball, based on winning percentage (Durham [International League] has a .731 winning percentage).

#### HERE ARE THE FEATS THE SOX ACHIEVED LAST NIGHT

- ▶ Cooper hit home runs in consecutive games (second time a Sox player has done this--Ryan Cordell 4/14 and 4/15).
- ▶ Cooper and Nieuwenhuis hit back-to-back home runs for the first time since 4/30/2015 v. Omaha (Shane Peterson and Ben Guez).
- ▶ All nine starters recorded at least one hit for the first time since 8/30/2016 v. New Orleans.
- ▶ The Sky Sox clubbed seven doubles (season-high).
- ▶ The 21 hits are the most in a road game since 5/30/2012 at Salt Lake (27 hits).
- ▶ The 16-8 mark is tied for the best start through 24 games (1997 season).

#### GUARDIANS OF THE STOLEN BASE

- ▶ The catching duo of **Andrew Susac** and **Tyler Heineman** currently leads the PCL in caught stealing percentage. Opposing runners are 7-for-118 (.611) against the pair (lone duo > .500)
- ▶ Heineman leads all PCL catchers, throwing out six runners in 11 attempts, good for a .545 mark.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

- ▶ RHP **Paolo Espino** makes his sixth start of the season, and first in his career against the Fresno Grizzlies
- ▶ The native of Panama and graduate of The Pendleton School in Bradenton, Fla., threw his second quality start of the season in a no-decision May 1 at Iowa (6 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 6 K...Sox lost 3-2).
- ▶ Espino looks to move up the Pacific Coast League strikeout leaderboard, where he currently sits in a tie for fifth place with Albuquerque's Jeff Hoffman and Las Vegas' Adam Wilk with 29 strikeouts.
- ▶ Espino also sits 4.1 IP behind Hoffman, Las Vegas' Ricky Knapp and El Paso's Matt Magill for most innings pitched in 2017.
- ▶ 2017 marks his 11th professional season, having been drafted by the Cleveland Indians in 10th round of the 2006 Draft.
- ▶ Spent 2016 with the Triple-A Syracuse Chiefs (Washington), where he went 8-11 with a 3.30 ERA in 26 appearances (24 starts).
- ▶ Signed as a minor league free agent with the Brewers on November 10, 2016, with an invitation to Spring Training included in the contract.
- ▶ Represented his home country of Panama in the 2006 and 2009 World Baseball Classic, as well as in the 2013 and 2017 WBC qualifiers.

#### CONSISTENT COOPER

- ▶ First baseman **Garrett Cooper** was named the Sky Sox Player of the Month for the month of April, finishing the month with a .320 batting average in 19 games during the season's first month.
- ▶ A model of consistency in the middle of the potent Sox lineup, Cooper leads the team with 27 RBIs through 24 games, which places him alone in third place in the PCL
- ▶ Cooper also leads Colorado Springs in total hits (32), five more than **Ryan Cordell's** 27.
- ▶ The first baseman has recorded a pair of lengthy hitting streaks...He started the season on 12-game season-opening streak and is currently on a seven-game tear with his two hits Friday night.
- ▶ In fact, there have only been two starts in which Cooper hasn't recorded at least one hit (April 21 v. Memphis -- game 2, April 24 v. Nashville).
- ▶ Cooper's season-high in production came April 13 at A-to-Zone Park, when he torched Memphis pitching, going 4-for-5 with 2 runs and 4 RBIs (tied the RBI mark Friday night in OK City).

**Miscellaneous/Personal:** Graduated from Pendleton (FL) High School, where he was a teammate of current Milwaukee Brewers Spanish translator Carlos Brizuela... Played for Team Panama in the 2006 and 2009 World Baseball Classic, and also played for his country during the WBC qualifiers in 2012 and 2016...Was named an Eastern League All-Star in 2010 with Double-A Akron (CLE) and finished the year with a 9-4 record and a 4.00 ERA...Led the Carolina League in earned run average (2.59) and WHIP (1.04) while playing for Class-A Advanced Kinston (CLE)...Is married to wife Leslie and the two have a daughter named Alana.
