#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► A 2:11 rain delay couldn't stop the Sky Sox from winning their fourth straight game Monday night, defeating Fresno, 12-5.  
 ► **Brett Phillips** went 3-for-5 with 4 RBIs to lead the offense, which has scored in double-figures in three of the past four games. Catcher Andrew Susac provided some pop with his second home run in as many games.

#### ON TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► Despite playing at the highest altitude in all of Minor League Baseball, the Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major categories.  
 ► Colorado Springs is currently tops in the PCL in slugging percentage and 2nd in team batting average behind Reno.  
 ► The Sox also sit near the top of the hitter-friendly PCL in pitching statistics, placing fourth in the league in Earned Run Average behind Oklahoma City, Omaha and Tacoma, second place in Runs Allowed behind Tacoma, and first in Hits Allowed and Earned Runs Allowed.  
 ► This potent combination has given the Sox the best record in the Pacific Coast league and second in Triple-A baseball, based on winning percentage (Durham [International League] has a .724 winning percentage).

#### GUARDIANS OF THE STOLEN BASE

► The catching duo of **Andrew Susac** and **Tyler Heineman** currently leads the PCL in caught stealing percentage. Opposing runners are 7-for-18 (.611) against the pair (lone duo > .500)  
 ► Heineman leads all PCL catchers, throwing out six runners in 11 attempts, good for a .545 mark.

#### FOURS GALORE

► With the win Monday night, the Sky Sox have won their fourth straight game, the second longest streak in 2017 behind their six-game streak in mid-April.  
 ► The Sox used three four-run innings to pull past Fresno, scoring eight runs in the final two innings, with Phillips leading the way with four RBIs.  
 ► During the four-game win streak, the Sox have utilized a four-run inning six times (1 on 5/5 @ OKC, 1 on 5/6 v. FRE, 1 on 5/7 v. FRE, 3 on 5/8 v. FRE).

#### TODAY'S STARTER

► RHP **Hiram Burgos** looks to secure his second win in his sixth appearance (fifth start) of the season.  
 ► Took the loss May 4 in Oklahoma City, allowing five earned runs in five innings Thursday.  
 ► Burgos was named the Sky Sox Pitcher of the Year and Pitcher of the Month for August/September after 10-10 with a 4.40 ERA. The righty won five of his last six starts, including five in a row from August 9 to August 31.  
 ► Made his MLB debut on April 20, 2013 against the Chicago Cubs (W, 5 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 1 K)  
 ► Represented Puerto Rico in the 2013 and 2017 World Baseball Classic, helping his island home reach the '17 championship against the United States.  
 ► Went 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA in three relief appearances for Team PR in the 2013 Classic...earned the win against Italy by throwing 3.2 scoreless innings (3 H, 2 BB, 4 K)  
 ► Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 6th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Fla.

#### CONSISTENT COOPER

► First baseman **Garrett Cooper** was named the Sky Sox Player of the Month for the month of April, finishing the month with a .320 batting average in 19 games during the season's first month.  
 ► A model of consistency in the middle of the potent Sox lineup, Cooper leads the team with 31 RBIs through 27 games, which places him alone in third place in the PCL.  
 ► Cooper also leads Colorado Springs in total hits (38), doubles (11), batting average (.345), slugging percentage (.609), and is tied for the team lead in home runs with Brett Phillips (6).  
 ► The first baseman has recorded a pair of lengthy hitting streaks...He started the season on 12-game season-opening streak and is currently on a 10-game tear with his one hit Monday.  
 ► Cooper's second on the team in on-base percentage (.383) behind Eric Sogard. In fact, Cooper has reached base in all but two games this season.  
 ► Cooper's season-high in production came April 13 at AutoZone Park, when he torched Memphis pitching, going 4-for-5 with 2 runs and 4 RBIs (tied the RBI mark Friday night in OK City).

Participated in the World Baseball Classic for Team Puerto Rico and went 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA in three relief appearances. **2012:** Named Brewers Minor League Player of the Year after going 10-4 with a 1.95 ERA in 28 games (27 starts) with Class-A Brevard County, Double-A Huntsville and Triple-A Nashville...was named Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April (shared), June and July...Was a Florida State League All-Star while pitching at Brevard County...was named Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for 8/27-9/3 at Nashville going 1-0 with 12.0 shutout IP over two starts.
