#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► The Colorado Springs Sky Sox lost the season finale against the Reno Aces, dropping Monday night's contest, 12-5.

► **Nick Noonan** drove in two runs to lead the offense, while **Nate Orf** and **Keon Broxton** each drove in one run.

#### STREAK WATCH

► **Ivan De Jesus** led off the fourth inning Sunday with a single to extend his on-base streak to 40 games (tied for the longest-active streak in the PCL w/ Oklahoma City's Alex Verdugo and Fresno's Tony Kemp).

► The 40-game on-base streak is now tied for the longest streak of its kind in franchise history, joining Trenidad Hubbard and Nelson Liriano for the No. 1 spot in team history.

#### REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major offensive categories.

► Colorado Springs is third in the PCL in team on-base percentage (.357) and fifth in both slugging percentage (.458) and batting average (.289).

► The Sox are also third in the league in runs scored (606) behind Fresno and Reno, and fourth in runs batted in (565) behind the Grizzlies, Aces and El Paso Chihuahuas.

► This combination has given the Sox the second-best record in the PCL in terms of winning percentage behind the Memphis Redbirds.

#### STORMING OUT OF THE BREAK

► Since returning to the Sky Sox on June 26, **Lewis Brinson** has had a red-hot bat to help fuel the Sox offense.

► The Brewers' No. 1 prospect has reached safely in all 21 games since his return to Colorado Springs, posting a .413 average (38-for-92) with 22 runs, eight doubles, three triples, four home runs, 18 RBI and nine walks.

► Brinson owns an 18-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team and the longest active streak in the Pacific Coast League, ahead of Salt Lake's Carlos Perez's 15-game hit streak.

► Brinson owns the fifth-longest active on-base streak in the PCL at 28 games.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

► RHP **Angel Ventura** makes his eighth career Triple-A start after receiving a promotion from Double-A Biloxi June 14.

► The native of Santo Domingo, D.R., took a loss July 18 in Omaha, allowing seven earned runs in five innings in his third start of 2017 against the Storm Chasers.

► The 7 1/3 innings is the second longest outing of Ventura's career, having tossed eight innings on July 27, 2013, against the DSL Nationals in Ventura's hometown of Santo Domingo.

► 2017 marks his seventh professional season, having signed with the Milwaukee Brewers prior to the 2011 season.

► Posted a season-high seven wins as a member of the Class-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in 2015, where he also struck out a season-high 126 batters.

► Spent 2016 between Class-A Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Biloxi, where he went a combined 5-7 with a 3.90 ERA.

#### WELCOME BACK, KEON!

► **Keon Broxton** made his first appearance in a Sky Sox uniform since 2016 and continued his recent hot streak at Security Service Field, driving in a run and going 3-for-3 with two walks.

► Broxton owns a five-game hitting streak dating back to last season, when he recorded at least one hit in each of his last four games before being recalled on July 25, 2016.

► During that stretch, Broxton is 13-for-22 (.591) with five runs, three doubles and five RBI. He has two two-hit games and three three-hit games.

#### BARBOSA'S BEAST MODE

► In six relief outings in the month of July, **Andrew Barbosa** has been a consistent presence out of the Sky Sox bullpen.

► Against Nashville, Round Rock, Iowa, Omaha and Reno, Barbosa has allowed one earned run in 12 innings of work, striking out 13 batters (including 10 against the Aces).

► The lefty has also dropped his earned run average from a 3.08 after July 1 to 4.85 entering the Tacoma series.
