#### IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► The Colorado Springs Sky Sox were shut out in their series opener against the Las Vegas 51s, dropping a 3-0 contest Saturday night at Cashman Field.  
 ► **Brandon Woodruff** tossed five shutout innings in a no-decision, striking out six batters and scattering five hits, while benefiting from some great defense in the early half of the contest.

#### STREAK WATCH

► **Ivan De Jesus** singled in the eighth inning Friday night to extend his franchise record on-base streak.  
 ► The 43-game on-base streak is the longest streak of its kind in franchise history, surpassing Trenidad Hubbard and Nelson Liriano, who both owned 40-game on-base streaks in the mid-1990s.  
 ► De Jesus' streak is currently the longest active on-base streak in all of professional baseball (including both MLB and MiLB) after Oklahoma City's Alex Verdugo's 41-game streak was snapped against Reno earlier in the week.

#### REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major offensive categories.  
 ► Colorado Springs is third in the PCL in both team on-base percentage (.361) and team batting average (.293), as well as fifth in slugging percentage (.464).  
 ► The Sox are also third in the league in both runs scored (650) and runs batted in (605) behind the Fresno Grizzlies and Reno Aces.  
 ► This combination has given the Sox the second-best record in the PCL in terms of winning percentage behind the Memphis Redbirds.

#### BOUNCING BACK NICELY

► After allowing four earned runs in 2/3 of an inning in his last outing against Reno, Brandon Woodruff bounced back Saturday against the other PCL team from the Silver State.  
 ► His six strikeouts were the most against a PCL opponent since Woodruff struck out nine Dodgers June 3 at Oklahoma City, and he shut out a PCL opponent for the first time since May 28 in Nashville.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

► RHP **Angel Ventura** makes his ninth career Triple-A start after receiving a promotion from Double-A Biloxi June 14.

► The native of Santo Domingo, D.R., took earned his fifth win of the season July 25 against Tacoma, allowing one earned run while scattering seven hits and striking out three batters in six innings.

► Threw 7 1/3 innings July 2 at Omaha. That's the second longest outing of Ventura's career, having tossed eight innings on July 27, 2013, against the DSL Nationals in Ventura's hometown of Santo Domingo.

► 2017 marks his seventh professional season, having signed with the Milwaukee Brewers prior to the 2011 season.

► Posted a season-high seven wins as a member of the Class-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in 2015, where he also struck out a season-high 126 batters.

► Spent 2016 between Class-A Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Biloxi, where he went a combined 5-7 with a 3.90 ERA.

#### GETTING INTO A GROOVE

► With his hit Thursday Saturday, **Nick Noonan** extended his season-long hitting streak to 11 games.

► His three-hits Thursday night are a new season-high after posting two-hit games seven times with the Sox in 2017...Noonan has recorded 17 three-hit games at the Triple-A level (and one more while in San Francisco). His career-high for hits in a Triple-A game is five, set on June 12, 2012, for the Fresno Grizzlies against the Sacramento River Cats.  
 ► In his last 10 games, Noonan has posted a .387 average (12-for-31) with six runs scored and 11 runs driven in.

#### SETTLING INTO TRIPLE-A

► **Mauricio Dubon** had his four-game hitting streak snapped Saturday night, but the infielder has been one of the team's hottest hitters of late.

► Over the past 10 games, Dubon is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with two home runs, 10 runs scored and 8 RBI.
