IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► The Colorado Springs Sky Sox scored their first runs of the series, but the Las Vegas 51s came from behind to pull away with a 12-6 victory at Cashman Field Sunday night.

► **Keon Broxton** hit a home run and drove in three runs, marking a season-high during his brief time with the Sky Sox. **Chris Colabello** hit a solo home run and scored two runs, while **Yadiel Rivera** and **Nate Orf** each drove in a run.

STREAK WATCH

► **Ivan De Jesus** singled in the eighth inning Friday night to extend his franchise record on-base streak.

► The 43-game on-base streak is the longest streak of its kind in franchise history, surpassing **Trenidad Hubbard** and **Nelson Liriano**, who both owned 40-game on-base streaks in the mid-1990s.

► De Jesus' streak is currently the longest active on-base streak in all of professional baseball (including both MLB and MiLB) after Oklahoma City's **Alex Verdugo's** 41-game streak was snapped against Reno earlier in the week.

REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major offensive categories.

► Colorado Springs is third in the PCL in both team on-base percentage (.360), and fifth in both team batting average (.291) and fifth in slugging percentage (.462).

► The Sox are also third in the league in both runs scored (656) and runs batted in (611) behind the Fresno Grizzlies and Reno Aces.

► This combination has given the Sox the second-best record in the PCL in terms of winning percentage behind the Memphis Redbirds.

SETTLING INTO TRIPLE-A

► **Mauricio Dubon** had his four-game hitting streak snapped Saturday night, but the infielder has been one of the team's hottest hitters of late.

► Over the past 10 games, Dubon is hitting .405 (17-for-42) with two home runs, 11 runs scored and 8 RBI.

► With his two-hit game Sunday night, the infielder has recorded 14 multi-hit games in 29 Triple-A games.

TONIGHT'S STARTER

► RHP **Taylor Jungmann** makes his tenth start for the Sox in 2017 in his fourth career appearance against the Las Vegas 51s.

► Earned his sixth Triple-A win of the season July 26 against Tacoma at Security Service Field, taking a perfect game into the sixth inning...Jungmann finished by allowing two earned runs on one hit while striking out seven Rainiers (Colorado Springs won 12-4 in eight innings).

► While on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, Jungmann made nine appearances (six starts) for the Shuckers, going 1-2 with a 4.36 earned run average while striking out 31 in 33 IP (called up to Colorado Springs on May 27).

► 2017 marks the third season in a Sky Sox uniform, appearing in 11 games in 2015 and eight games in 2016.

► Has appeared in 29 games for the Milwaukee Brewers, making 27 starts during the 2015 and 2016 seasons.

► Selected by the Brewers in the 1st round of the 2011 draft out of the University of Texas and spent three full seasons in the minor leagues before making his Major League debut June 9, 2015, at Pittsburgh...Jungmann earned the victory in a 4-1 Milwaukee win (7 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 K).

RECAPPING THE STREAK

► **Nick Noonan** went hitless Sunday night to snap his season-long 11-game streak, but Noonan has been a consistent presence in the middle of the lineup.

► His three-hits Thursday night are a new season-high after posting two-hit games seven times with the Sox in 2017...Noonan has recorded 17 three-hit games at the Triple-A level (and one more while in San Francisco). His career-high for hits in a Triple-A game is five, set on June 12, 2012, for the Fresno Grizzlies against the Sacramento River Cats.

► In his last 10 games, Noonan has posted a .387 average (12-for-31) with six runs scored and 11 runs driven in.

REACHING NEW HIGHS

► **Keon Broxton** drove in three runs Sunday night, marking the most RBI in a game since joining the Sox on July 24.

► While with the So in 2016, Broxton drove in a season-high three runs twice (May 11 and May 13 at New Orleans).
