IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

► The Colorado Springs Sky Sox battled back with seven runs over the middle innings, but the Memphis Redbirds took Sunday's contest, 15-7.
 ► **Rene Garcia** drove in a pair of runs to lead the offense, while five players recorded a two-hit game.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS, MY FRIEND!

► Despite Sunday's cancellation, the Colorado Springs Sky Sox clinched the PCL American Northern Division title with Oklahoma City's doubleheader split against Omaha.
 ► This means that the Sox have reached the playoffs for the first time since 1997, breaking a 20-year playoff drought.
 ► This four-game series with the Redbirds serves as a playoff preview, as Memphis won the PCL American Southern Division.

REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox are among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major offensive categories.
 ► Colorado Springs is first in the league in team batting average (.292), second in team on-base percentage (.361) and tied for fourth in team slugging percentage (.456) with the Albuquerque Isotopes.
 ► The Sox are also third in the league in runs scored (813) and fourth in runs batted in (757) behind Reno, Fresno and El Paso (RBI).

TODAY'S STARTER

► **RHP Wuilder Rodriguez** makes his Triple-A Debut after receiving a promotion prior to Monday's contest.
 ► The right-hander was signed as a non-drafted free agent on March 7, 2015.
 ► Led Rookie Helena in earned run average (4.48), wins (5) and innings pitched (60.1) during the 2016 season in the Pioneer League.
 ► Was named the Pioneer League Player of the Week (August 8-14) and was named to the league's postseason All-Star team.
 ► Rodriguez placed third among relievers in the Pioneer League in lowest batting average against (.203) and lowest walks per nine innings pitched (1.1) and was fourth in fewest baserunners per nine innings (9.37)
 ► The RHP has pitched in 27 games this season for the Class-A Advanced Carolina Mudcats and three games for the Double-A Biloxi Shuckers.

FINISHING OFF ON A HIGH NOTE

► **Nate Orf** finishes the 2017 season as the hottest hitter on the Sky Sox roster over his last 10 games.
 ► During this stretch, Orf is batting .441 (15-for-34) with two home runs, 10 runs scored and five runs batted in.
 ► Orf is the owner of a five-game hitting streak, posting a three-hit and a four-hit game v. Round Rock & Memphis.

RICK SWEET - MANAGER

BORN: SEPTEMBER 7, 1952, LONGVIEW, WA **RESIDES:** BUCKEYE, AZ **OPENING DAY AGE:** 64

Rick Sweet enters his fourth season in the Brewers organization and his third as manager of the Sky Sox. Prior to joining the organization in 2014 as manager of the Nashville Sounds, Sweet spent the previous nine seasons in the Reds organization as manager of the Louisville Bats (2005-11) and as the Reds' catching coordinator (2012-13).

The 2017 season marks his 27th year as a minor-league manager, a managerial career that dates back to 1987. As one of the most successful managers in Minor League Baseball, he owns a 1,794-1,739 (.508) career record and his 1,798 wins rank fourth-most among active minor league managers entering the 2017 season.

During Sweet's stint in Louisville from 2005-11, he became the franchise's all-time winningest manager with a 539-465 (.537) record. From 2008-10 his Bats won three straight International League West Division championships. He was named IL Manager of the Year in 2008 and 2009 and was *Baseball America's* 2010 Triple-A Manager of the Year. He was also recognized as Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 1994 while with Triple-A Tucson.



Sweet previously managed in the Seattle (1987-88), Houston (1989-95), New York - NL (1997), Montreal (1998, 2000), San Deigo (2001-03) and Detroit (2004) minor league systems. He served with the Astros as first base coach in 1996 and with the Expos as field coordinator from 1999-2000.

Sweet is a three-time Triple-A All-Star Game manager, having received the honor twice in the PCL with Tucson (1993) and Portland (2003), as well as with Louisville in the IL in 2009.

The former catcher had a nine-year playing career (1975-83) including three seasons in the majors with San Diego (1978), New York - NL (1982) and Seattle (1982-83). Following his playing days, Sweet became bullpen catcher for the Mariners (1984) and then spent the next two years as an advanced scout with Seattle (1985-86).

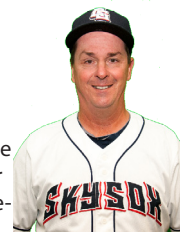
