#### REACHING THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

► The Sky Sox finished the 2017 season among the Pacific Coast League leaders in several major offensive categories.

► Colorado Springs is first in the league in team batting average (.291), second in team on-base percentage (.361) and fourth in team slugging percentage (.456).

► The Sox are also third in the league in runs scored (818) and fourth in runs batted in (759) behind Reno, Fresno and El Paso (RBI).

#### PITCHING TO NEW HEIGHTS

► The Sky Sox finished with a 4.54 ERA, good for the 6th-best in the PCL. Since the league's expansion to 16 teams in 1998, this is the 1st time the Sox have finished higher than 11th.

► The 4.54 ERA is the 5th-best mark in team history and the best ERA since a 4.47 mark in 2003.

► Wei-Chung Wang (2.05) & Taylor Jungmann (2.59) have the 2nd & 6th best ERA in team history (Min. 50 IP).

#### BACK IN THE PLAYOFFS

► Wednesday night marks the first postseason game for the Colorado Springs Sky Sox in 7,306 days. The last time the Sox were in the playoffs was against the Phoenix Firebirds on September 5, 1997.

► The last Sox postseason win came on September 15, 1995, at Security Service Field against the Salt Lake Buzz...that win clinched the 1995 Pacific Coast League championship.

► Current Milwaukee Brewers manager Craig Counsell was a member of that 1995 championship team.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER

► RHP **Taylor Jungmann** takes the ball in game one in what will be his second start in 2017 at AutoZone Park.

► Earned a win in his final regular season start August 31 in Round Rock, tossing six scoreless innings in a 4-0 win.

► 2017 marks the third season in a Sky Sox uniform, appearing in 11 games in 2015 and eight games in 2016.

► Has appeared in 29 games for the Milwaukee Brewers, making 27 starts during the 2015 and 2016 seasons.

► Selected by the Brewers in the 1st round of the 2011 draft out of the University of Texas...made his MLB debut June 9, 2015, at Pittsburgh (7 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 K...4-1 W).

#### A HIGH-OCTANE OFFENSE

► The Sky Sox finished 2017 with the best team batting average in the Pacific Coast League (.291). This is only the seventh time that the Sox have led the league in that category.

► **Ivan De Jesus** had the seventh-best batting average by a Sox player batting in a minimum of 90 games (and the second-highest average in the PCL this season).

► **Nate Orf** scored 103 runs this season, one behind Reno's Christian Walker for the PCL lead. Orf's mark is the fourth-most runs scored by a Sox player (Eric Young, Jr., scored 118 runs in 2009).

► **Kyle Wren** stole 26 bases for the Sky Sox this season, tying for the PCL lead in that category. This is the fourth time in team history that a Sox player has at least tied for the team lead in stolen bases (Trenidad Hubbard in 1995, Terry Jones in 1997 and Eric Young, Jr., in 2009).

**THE JUNGMANN FILE: 2016:** Went 0-5 with a 7.76 ERA in eight games (six starts) with Milwaukee...Made his first career opening day roster...Went 1-3 with a 9.87 ERA in eight starts with Triple-A Colorado Springs. **2015:** Began the season with the Sky Sox going 2-3 with a 6.37 ERA in 11 games (9 starts)...Made his Major League debut on 6/9 at Pittsburgh and earned a 3-1 victory after allowing a run on three hits over 7.0 IP...Went 9-8 with a 3.77 ERA in 21 starts with the Brewers...Was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for August after going 3-2 with a 3.12 ERA in five starts. **2014:** Entered the season as the sixth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*... Combined to go 12-10 with a 3.57 ERA (61 ER/153.2 IP) and 147 strikeouts in 28 games (27 starts) between Class AA Huntsville and Class AAA Nashville...Went 4-4 with a 2.77 ERA (16 ER/52.0 IP) in nine starts with Huntsville...Was named to the Southern League's midseason All-Star Team...Promoted to Nashville on May 18...In 19 games (18 starts) with the Sounds, he went 8-6 with a 3.98 ERA (45 ER/101.2 IP) with 101 strikeouts. **2013:** Entered the season as the third-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*...Spent the entire season with Huntsville going 10-10 with a 4.33 ERA (67 ER/139.1 IP) with 82 strikeouts in 26 starts...was named a Southern League midseason All-Star. **2012:** Entered the season ranked as the second- best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*...In his first pro season, went 11-6 with a 3.53 ERA (60 ER/153.0 IP) with 99 strikeouts in 26 starts...Tied for the Florida State League lead in wins (11) and ranked second in innings pitched (153.0). **Miscellaneous/Personal:** Pitched at the University of Texas for three seasons and was unanimously selected 2011 Big 12 Pitcher of the Year...Earned First Team All-Big 12 honors and Big 12 All-Academic recognition in 2010 and 2011...Won the 2011 Dick Howser Trophy as the top collegiate baseball player in the country and was a finalist for the 2011 Golden Spikes Award...Was named a First Team All-American by *Baseball America* in 2010 and 2011.
